

Camp Descriptions

Explorer Camps (K-2nd Grade)

Three days and two nights is long enough for children to be comfortable with camp life and short enough that campers will not have difficulty being away from home. The schedule includes time for Bible themes, arts & crafts, swimming, nature hikes, and cooperative games all geared to support and expand new campers' horizons.

Discoverer Camps (3rd-5th Grade)

Each day at Discoverer Camp will include opportunity for fun and play through a variety of sign-up activities where each camper will make choices about their afternoon's activities. The morning program will include Biblical instruction and activities related to our theme of "Beyond Belief." Voyager Camps (6th-8th Grade)

Adventurer Camp (9th-12th Grade)
